

This is an informative document according to and for the effects of Article 13 of Regulation (EU) 2016/679 (GDPR).

In compliance with Regulation (EU) 2016/679 (GDPR) and subsequent additions and modifications, we are providing you with the necessary information regarding the processing of personal data provided. This information is provided in accordance with Article 13 GDPR.

1. DATA CONTROLLER

2. TYPES OF DATA PROCESSED

The Controller, within the scope of the activities aimed at the purposes referred to in point 3 below and to the extent necessary to achieve those purposes, processes the common personal data of the data subjects who will participate voluntarily in the interviews. The Controller does not generally process any special personal data pursuant to Articles 9 and 10 GDPR. Data processing may be carried out both in paper and electronic form.

3. PURPOSE AND LEGAL BASIS OF PROCESSING

The collection of data and interviews with data subjects are aimed at investigations and research related to the products that Day One is committed to developing within the scope of its project activity for consortia or participating companies.

The personal data provided will be processed, in compliance with the conditions of lawfulness pursuant to Article 6 of EU Regulation 2016/679, by virtue of explicit consent given by the data subject (Article 6 letter b) at the time of the interview. Participation in the interview is in any case always on a voluntary basis, therefore the data subject may object at any time to the processing, even after the interview, and may request the deletion of his/her personal data, without prejudice to the lawfulness of the processing carried out up to the exercise of the right to object, as well as the Controller's right to keep the information provided in the interview in anonymous form. The contact details may be used to contact the data subject in order to conduct new interviews, always connected to the same purposes described in this point.

No activities involving automated decision-making or profiling are carried out.

4. RECIPIENTS OR CATEGORIES OF RECIPIENTS OF DATA

The personal data provided may be communicated to recipients, who may be identified and appointed pursuant to Article 28 of EU Regulation 2016/679, for activities related to the purposes referred to in point 3. The data may also be communicated to recipients belonging to the following categories:

- Any third-party private subjects, such as tax or occupational safety consultants, IT consultants, legal firms;
- Tax agency;
- Pension institutions and tax authorities, for the purpose of fulfilling any social security, welfare, insurance and tax obligations;
- Competent authorities to comply with legal obligations and/or provisions dictated by public bodies.
- Any universities, research centers or third-party private entities directly involved in project activities with Day One based on contractual relationships.

The subjects belonging to the aforementioned categories, with reference to the data provided, may perform the function of Data Processor, or will operate autonomously as separate Data Controllers. The list of any external processors is constantly updated and available at the Data Controller's office, for any needs that the data subject may express and document.

The data is not generally transferred to third parties for marketing purposes, and if necessary, it may be transferred for such purposes only after obtaining specific and express consent from the data subject.

5. DATA TRANSFER TO A THIRD COUNTRY AND/OR AN INTERNATIONAL ORGANIZATION

The personal data provided will not be transferred abroad inside or outside the European Union, with the only following exceptions:

Partners involved in project activities with Day One;

Email, cloud, instant messaging services or website domains provided by service providers located outside of Europe, all for the sole purposes of data storage or transmission.

6. DATA RETENTION PERIOD OR CRITERIA FOR DETERMINING SUCH PERIOD

The processing will be carried out in an automated and/or manual manner, with methods and tools aimed at ensuring maximum security and confidentiality, by specifically appointed individuals.

In compliance with Article 5(1)(e) of the EU Regulation 2016/679, the personal data collected will be kept in a form that allows the identification of the data subjects for a period of time not exceeding the achievement of the purposes for which the personal data are processed.

The retention of the personal data provided is determined based on the current legislation on the retention of accounting records and the prescription terms of civil law rights, specifically, currently for a maximum period of 10 years.

Due to the nature and purposes of the data collection, the data may be kept for a period exceeding 10 years. The data subject will always have the right to request cancellation by communicating the request to the certified email address dayone@pec.it, except in cases of data related to contractual or fiscal requirements, for which the aforementioned term will apply.

7. NATURE OF PROVIDING DATA AND CONSEQUENCES OF REFUSAL

Providing data and giving consent to processing is a necessary requirement for achieving the purposes mentioned in point n.3.

The Controller does not use the data for further and/or unrelated activities other than those related to the aforementioned purposes, any other use will be possible only through a specific and separate request for consent.

8. RIGHTS OF DATA SUBJECTS

You may exercise your rights, as expressed by Articles 15, 16, 17, 18, 19, 20, 21, and 22 of EU Regulation 2016/679, by contacting the Controller, or the Data Processor, or the Data Protection Officer pursuant to Article 38(4) if appointed. The data subject has the right, at any time, to ask the Controller for access to his/her personal data, rectification, erasure, or restriction of processing.

Furthermore, he/she has the right to object, at any time, to the processing of his/her data, as well as to request data portability. Without prejudice to any other administrative and judicial remedy, if the data subject believes that the processing of his/her data violates the provisions of EU Regulation 2016/679, pursuant to Article 15(f) of the aforementioned Regulation, the data subject has the right to lodge a complaint with the Italian Data Protection Authority (Garante per la protezione dei dati personali) and, with reference to Article 6(1)(a) and Article 9(2)(a), the right to withdraw consent at any time.

In case of a request for data portability, the Controller will provide the personal data subject to the request in a structured, commonly used, and machine-readable format, subject to paragraphs 3 and 4 of Article 20 of EU Regulation 2016/679.
